## RULES

### 1) LOCAL RULES

The rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf club of St Andrews will apply.

#### OUT OF BOUNDS

The boundaries of the course are defined by **white stakes**. Any ball coming to rest beyond such posts is out of bounds.

#### WATER HAZARDS

All water hazards are identified by **yellow stakes**.

- Red Stakes - Lateral Water Hazard.

- Yellow Stakes - Water Hazard.

#### LATERAL WATER HAZARDS

The lakes to the right of the 17th fairway are lateral water hazards and are identified by **red stakes**. Rule 26-1 applies.

#### GROUND UNDER REPAIR

Ground under repair (GUR) is identified by **blue stakes** or temporary roped off areas. These areas are to be avoided and relief from these areas is to be taken under rule 25-1

### 2) IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

Sprinklers, control boxes, drain covers, cart paths and course furniture are immovable obstructions. Relief may be taken under rule 24-2.

Stones and shells may be removed from bunkers provided the lie of the ball is not improved.

### 3) STAKED TREES

If a staked tree interferes with a player's intended swing, relief may be taken under rule 24-2.

### 4) NATURE RESERVE

The valley between the teeing ground and the green at the 6th hole is a nature reserve and may not be entered. Any ball coming to rest in this area must be abandoned. A dropping zone is marked out on the green side of the valley and players may play a second ball from that point under penalty of one stroke. It is not necessary to play a second ball from the tee.

### 5) DISTANCE MARKERS

The distance markers on the tee positions and on the side of the fairway are measured in metres to the **centre** of the green.

- One Stripe - 100m • Two Stripes - 150m • Three Stripes - 200m
- Four Stripes - 250m

### 6) GOLF CARTS

Due care must be taken at all times when driving golf carts especially when crossing public roads and the viaduct at the 6th hole. Please keep carts away from tees and greens. It is forbidden for more than two persons to ride in a cart and nobody under the age of 16 may drive.

### 7) ETIQUETTE

- No player shall commence his or her round without the permission of the starter.

- Please rake bunkers, replace divots and repair pitch marks.

- Proper golf shoes with soft spikes must be worn.

- Players should adhere to the golfers' dress code. No jeans, tracksuits, sports shorts, tee shirts or swimwear will be permitted.

- Any match that loses one clear hole on the match in front should call through the following group.
